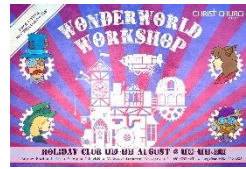
Summer locking up: During the summer the church centre is much quieter than usual. If

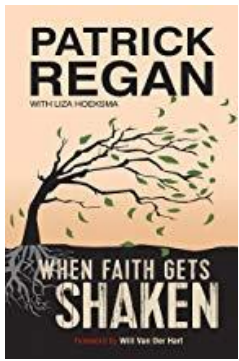
Potential Table Tennis Club
